



REGULATION

ON THE HOLDING OF SPECIAL CONTESTS OF "INCLUSIVE DANCE" INTERNATIONAL CHARITY DANCE FESTIVAL

General provisions:

The goal of special contests is to create conditions for active and comprehensive coverage of events aimed at social integration of people with disabilities through dancing in Russia and abroad.

Special contests are conducted within the framework of "Inclusive Dance" International Charity Dance Festival.

Everyone, regardless of age, education, citizenship and place of residence is invited to take part in the contests by preparing works of visual art, photographs, video films and press publications about inclusive dance (joint dance of people with and without disabilities) in Russia and worldwide.

Special contests:

1. Exhibition and contest of visual art
2. Exhibition and contest of photographs
3. Contest of publications
4. Contest of video films

Topics

The topic of the contest is social integration of people with disabilities via inclusive dance, a form of joint dancing art of people with and without disabilities.

Categories of participants

Professional. Professional artists, photographers, journalists, documentary specialists can participate under this category.

Amateur. Everyone, regardless of age, special training in the designated field can take part in this category.

Requirements to works

1. Exhibition and contest in visual arts "Artists for Inclusive Dance!"

Works of visual art of the at least A3 size (297*420mm) are accepted for participation. They can be done in any technique (oil, water colours, gouache, crayons, chalks, application, mixed technique etc). The work should not be a copied painting/drawing, should be done by the author independently and reflect the topic.

2. Exhibition and contest of photographs "Wonderful Moments of Inclusive Dance"

Prints of colour and black&white photographs of the at least A4 size (210*297mm) are accepted for participation. Works should meet the requirement of being suitable for printing. Works on CDs in the jpg format are also accepted. Resolution – at least 300 dpi (paper copy is obligatory). These can be separate photographs, collages, photo publications reflecting everyday activities of inclusive dancers.

3. Contest of journalistic publications "To Integration of Society Through Inclusive Dance!"

Articles, reports, essays, interviews, portraits etc published in magazines, newspapers, online editions, official websites of organisations, in social networking websites and blogs are accepted for participation. The work should not exceed 10 pages of typewritten text in 2-line spacing, 14 font size.

4. Contest of video films "Inclusive Dance: Events and People"

Video films on DVD, DVD-R, CD or CD-R carriers (AVI, MOV formats are allowed) are accepted for participation. Each work should be on a separate disc in an envelope (box) and the disc should have initials, title of the work, timing. The video material should also have an explanatory note (in a *.doc format) with information about the author(s) and a brief summary of the film.

Deadline and venue

Works for contests are accepted from 1 May to 20 October.

The works of winners will be presented at the Synthesis of Inclusive Art Exhibition which will open on 21 November in pavilion 3 (3d floor) of the Crocus Expo International Exhibition Center, Moscow.

Admission conditions

Works should be sent to this post address:, Ul. Shukhova, d. 17, korp. 2, 115162 Moscow, Russian Federation with a "for a special contest" note on the envelope.

Each author can send one or more works. The work should reflect the topic of the contest. Folded and bent works are not admitted. Works sent for the contest will not be returned or reviewed.

The upper right angle on the back should contain information about the author: initials, age, special training (if there is such), full address with the postcode and phone number (email).

For preliminary examination you can send links to published works, digital versions or scanned copies of works to the email address info@inclusive-dance.ru. Information about the author should be included in the body of email.

Evaluation

Winners will be chosen by members of the competent jury. Works will be assessed under two criteria: their artistic level and the originality of the plot.

Awards

All works admitted for the contest will be published in social networking accounts of the festival and on the official website of the festival at <http://inclusive-dance.ru>.

The works of winners will be presented at the Synthesis of Inclusive Art Exhibition which will open on 21-22 November and the best ones will be included into the Festival's Diary printed edition.

All participants will receive certificates. Winners will be presented with gifts from sponsors of the festival.

The jury and the organising committee can define categories and create additional prizes.

The works of winners will be put out on charity sales. The money raised at the sales will be spent on the dance rehabilitation programs for people with disabilities.
